Question: If God made us to become saints, how can we do so?

Answer: This is a question we should ask ourselves every day of our lives! The answer to this question is neverending.

It's true, we are made to be saints. God made us to be one with Him forever in Heaven. We call this holiness, sanctity or saintliness. But how do we become saints?

First, we seek the truth. Truth is discovered by faith. Faith is not just believing in something we cannot know for sure. It's not just wishful thinking. Faith is knowledge. Certain knowledge. We ultimately obtain faith by allowing God to speak to our inner consciences and reveal that which is true. This happens when two things are present. First, we engage our minds in the truth, such as in the Scripture, the Catechism of the Catholic Church, the teachings of the saints, etc. Second, reading the truth is not enough. We also need the "gift" of faith, meaning that when we hear the truth, God needs to confirm it as "true" in our consciences. God's voice first revealed the truth through the Scripture, the Church, or the saint, but then God tells us in our souls that this is His Truth. When this happens, we must believe. When this happens, we are gifted with faith. We know, with deep interior certitude, that which God revealed.

Second, this process of coming to know the truth in faith is strengthened by prayer. When we pray, it's like adding fuel to a fire. The fire, which is faith, grows in intensity. As it grows in intensity, we grow in faith.

Third, we must live what we come to know through faith. This is an act of our wills. When we choose to live the faith we come to know, we grow in charity, holiness, and saintliness. We become saints.

Though this is a greatly simplified explanation of the path to holiness, it should point you in the right direction.

Pregunta: Si Dios nos hizo santos, ¿cómo podemos serlo?

Respuesta: Esta es una pregunta que deberíamos hacernos todos los días de nuestra vida. La respuesta a esta pregunta es interminable.

Es verdad, estamos hechos para ser santos. Dios nos hizo para ser uno con Él para siempre en el Cielo. A esto lo llamamos santidad. Pero, ¿cómo llegamos a ser santos?

Primero, buscamos la verdad. La verdad se descubre por la fe. La fe no es sólo creer en algo que no podemos saber con certeza. No es sólo un deseo. La fe es conocimiento. Conocimiento cierto. En última instancia, obtenemos la fe permitiendo que Dios hable a nuestra conciencia interior y nos revele lo que es verdad. Esto sucede cuando se dan dos cosas. Primero, ocupamos nuestras mentes en la verdad, como en la Escritura, el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, las enseñanzas de los santos, etc. En segundo lugar, no basta con leer la verdad. También necesitamos el «don» de la fe, lo que significa que cuando oímos la verdad, Dios necesita confirmarla como «verdadera» en nuestras conciencias. La voz de Dios reveló primero la verdad a través de la Escritura, la Iglesia o el santo, pero luego Dios nos dice en nuestras almas que esa es Su Verdad. Cuando esto sucede, debemos creer. Cuando esto sucede, estamos dotados de fe. Conocemos, con profunda certeza interior, aquello que Dios nos ha revelado.

En segundo lugar, este proceso de llegar a conocer la verdad en la fe se fortalece con la oración. Cuando rezamos, es como echar leña al fuego. El fuego, que es la fe, crece en intensidad. A medida que crece en intensidad, nosotros crecemos en fe.

En tercer lugar, debemos vivir lo que conocemos a través de la fe. Es un acto de nuestra voluntad. Cuando elegimos vivir la fe que conocemos, crecemos en caridad, santidad y santidad. Nos hacemos santos.

Aunque ésta es una explicación muy simplificada del camino hacia la santidad, debería orientarte en la dirección correcta.

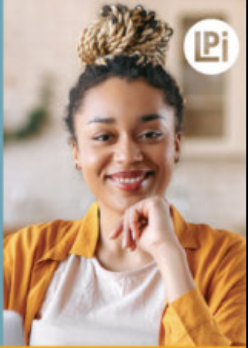
