Kids K-6 are invited to step through the mist into Rainforest Falls VBS, **June 22-26, 2026** at St. Peter's!

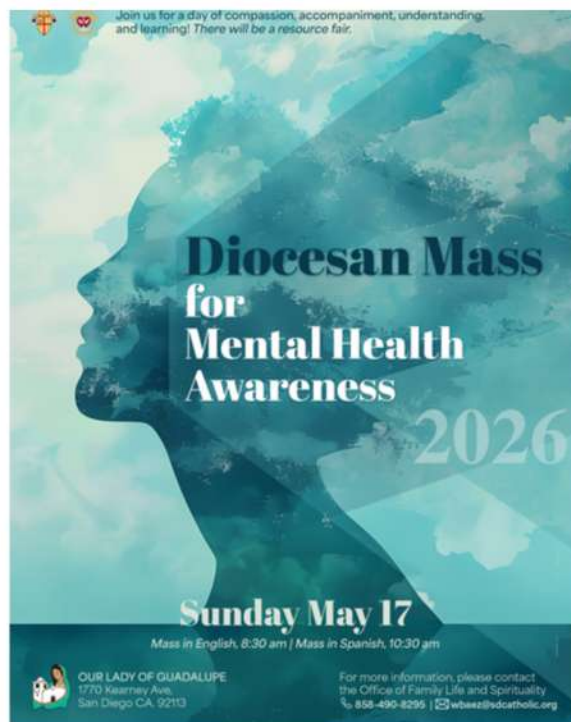
