Romper la cadena de causalidad

Este domingo se centra en el perdón, y la mayoría de nosotros tenemos algo que aprender sobre este importante acto. En el Libro de Sirácida, nuestra primera lectura, se describe lo terribles que son la ira y el enojo.

El Salmo habla maravillosamente del amor absolvente de Dios: Dios es bondadoso y misericordioso, lento a la ira y rico en compasión. La segunda lectura dice que no debemos vivir para nosotros mismos, sino para los demás. Debemos imitar a Dios. El perdón es un ingrediente fundamental de vivir para Dios y para los demás. Las personas no siempre actúan correctamente, y debemos perdonarlas como lo hace Dios. El perdón es el don y la meta. Pero, ¿en qué consiste?

Nuestra cultura tiene ideas bastante diversas al respecto. Para algunos es un acto condescendiente que solo realiza una persona que está por encima de otra —un rey o una reina, un juez, un jefe o una estrella de los medios de comunicación—, alguien que se inclina para conceder el perdón. Para otros significa «puedo perdonar, pero nunca podré olvidar». Quizá esto signifique: seguiré enfadado para siempre, pero nunca actuaré en consecuencia.

El Domingo de Pascua de 1960, aquel vidente de la verdad y amante de Dios, Dag Hammarskjöld, escribió una interpretación que me conmovió: el perdón rompe la cadena de causalidad porque quien te «perdona» —por amor— asume sobre sí mismo las consecuencias de lo que has hecho. El perdón, por lo tanto, siempre implica un sacrificio.

Apliquemos estas reflexiones al Evangelio. En él, Jesús cuenta una larga parábola sobre un siervo al que su señor perdona, pero que luego sale y se niega a perdonar a sus propios compañeros. A unas seis líneas del final, el dueño de la viña lo llama «siervo malvado». ¿Cuál es la lección? Que la motivación más profunda del perdón es la gratitud amorosa.

Mientras permanecemos en la presencia de Cristo este domingo, especialmente si podemos recibir la comunión, sintamos su amor perdonador, tan profundamente simbolizado en el sacramento. Dejemos que nuestra gratitud fluya hacia los demás.

Breaking the Chain of Causality

This Sunday is about forgiveness, and most of us have something to learn about this important act. In the Book of Sirach, our First Reading, tells how awful wrath and anger are, and how the sinner "hugs them tight," a wonderful image. Release them and let them go, it says.

The Psalm speaks beautifully about God's absolving love: God is kind and merciful, slow to anger, rich in compassion. The Second Reading says we ought to live not for ourselves but for others. We should imitate God. When we live for the Lord, it says, we will also be graced to die for the Lord. Forgiveness is a major ingredient of living for God and for others. People do not always do right, and we need to forgive them as God does. Forgiveness is the gift and the goal. But what does it consist of?

Our culture has some pretty diverse ideas about this. For some it is a condescending act performed only by a person who is higher than another—a King or Queen or a judge or a boss or a media star—someone who leans down to grant pardon. For others it means "I can forgive but I can never forget." Perhaps this means, I will remain angry forever but I will never act upon it.

On Easter Sunday of 1960, that seer of truth and lover of God, Dag Hammarskjöld, wrote an interpretation that moved me: Forgiveness breaks the chain of causality because he who "forgives" you—out of love—takes upon himself the consequences of what you have done. Forgiveness, therefore, always entails a sacrifice.

Let us apply these insights to the Gospel. There, Jesus tells a long and involved parable about a servant who is pardoned by the master but then goes out and refuses, viciously, to forgive his own fellow servants. At about six lines from the end the owner of the vineyard calls him a "wicked servant" and says, "should you not have had pity on your fellow servant, as I had pity on you?" What is the lesson? That the deepest motivation for forgiveness is loving gratitude.

As we dwell in Christ's presence this Sunday, especially if we are able to receive communion, let us sense his forgiving love, signified so deeply in the sacrament. Let us allow our gratitude to flow to others.
