MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

Cada mes de diciembre, los sacerdotes de mi diócesis nos reunimos para una cena de Navidad con nuestro obispo. Somos casi doscientos en una misma sala: recién ordenados y jubilados hace tiempo, párrocos de grandes comunidades y confesores discretos, hombres llenos de energía y otros que se mueven con más lentitud. Algunos exhiben éxitos visibles; otros llevan heridas ocultas. Es un tapiz de vocaciones y vidas. Cuando el obispo nos da las gracias, siempre me siento conmovido. Por un instante, nuestras diferencias no importan. Lo que importa es que nos pertenecemos unos a otros. Suelo salir de esa velada con una profunda sensación de paz, pero también con una toma de conciencia aleccionadora. Nada marchita más rápido la alegría en la viña del Señor que la comparación. El hábito silencioso de medir, clasificar y guardar resentimiento puede infiltrarse incluso entre quienes sirven a Dios con sinceridad. Eso es precisamente lo que Jesús pone de manifiesto en la parábola de hoy sobre los trabajadores de la viña. Los primeros obreros no se molestan porque se les haya tratado injustamente; se enfadan porque a otros se les trató con generosidad. Su resentimiento les impide ver el don que ya tienen en sus manos. Cuando el dueño de la viña pregunta: "¿Vas a tener envidia porque yo soy generoso?", señala la verdadera herida. Esta tensión resuena a lo largo de la historia de la salvación: el hermano mayor que guarda rencor al hijo pródigo, el siervo fiel que desprecia al que llegó tarde. Jesús no niega el esfuerzo de quienes han soportado el calor de la jornada, pero se niega a permitir que la misericordia de Dios se convierta en un juego de suma cero. Al final, la recompensa de la viña no se trata de justicia distributiva, sino de pertenencia. La alegría que se nos ofrece es la comunión con un Padre generoso, que se deleita en reunir a los que llegan temprano y a los que llegan tarde, a los fuertes y a los débiles, en una misma familia de gracia.

GOSPEL MEDITATION

Every December, the priests of my diocese gather for a Christmas dinner with our bishop. Nearly 200 of us in one room: newly ordained and long retired, pastors of large parishes and quiet confessors, men full of energy and others moving more slowly. Some carry visible success; others bear hidden wounds. It is a tapestry of vocations and lives. When the bishop thanks us, I am always moved. For a moment, none of our differences matter. What matters is that we belong to one another. I usually leave that evening with a deep sense of peace, but also with a sober realization. Nothing drains joy from the vineyard of the Lord faster than comparison. The quiet habit of measuring, ranking, and resenting can creep in even among those who sincerely serve God.

That is what Jesus exposes in today's parable of the workers in the vineyard. The early laborers are not upset because they were treated unjustly; they are angry because others were treated generously. Their resentment blinds them to the gift already in their hands. When the landowner asks, "Are you envious because I am generous?" he names the real wound. This tension echoes throughout salvation history: the elder brother resenting the prodigal, the faithful servant scorning the latecomer. Jesus does not deny the labor of those who have borne the heat of the day, but he refuses to let God's mercy become a zero-sum game. In the end, the vineyard's reward is not about fairness but belonging. The joy offered is communion with a generous Father, who delights in gathering early and late, strong and weak, into one household of grace.
